- Must be 17 years of age, and have high school diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license & own transportation
- Cannot have any felony convictions in your background
- Must pass a drug screening test

## The training:

is a four-year, registered apprenticeship program. The training is paid for by your employer and can count towards college credit. This results in no student loans!

Advanced placement testing available upon request.



## Apprentices:

are full-time paid electrical field employees who also attend related technical instruction classes. Classes are in the evening with in-person and online options. Apprentice starting wages are competitive with 5% increases steadily throughout the 4-year program.

## To fulfill an IEC apprenticeship, you must:

Complete 576 hours of related technical instruction training and 8,000 hours of on-the-job training which is usually completed in about four or five years.
